This half term, we will be revising and building on all the skills we learnt in reception last year. We will be using a variety of materials and in lots of new exciting ways to support this.




PE - We will doing a range of activities, learning lots of new skills.

Street Detectives

Quality Street

In 1890 John Mackintosh and his wife opened a shop in Halifax, where they created a new kind of sweet by mixing hard toffee with runny caramel. They were so successful that in 1898 they expanded the operation to build the world's first toffee factory.

Many year ago, only the rich could afford boxed chocolates made with elaborate packaging that often cost as much as the chocolates themselves. The Mackintoshes set out to produce boxes of chocolates that could be sold at a reasonable price and would be available to working families.

Quality Street had been created. We are going to look at the creation of Quality Streets and we may also try a few!



We will be looking at how Halifax has developed over time and differences and similarities from today. We will look at old photographs and have a go at drawing some ourselves. We will also look at the local area now and see what landmarks we can identify.
